# Why did we start Mission to Kindness? (short version)

It was a combination of two things, well... maybe three things. 1. We had just started a unit on Bucket Filling, which the kids know is a metaphor for showing kindness and empathy. (I teach counseling/character classes for the Lyle and Oakdale students.) 2. In the middle of one of these teaching days, I learned that my dear friend and mentor, Debbie Evans, had passed away. (She had previously been a counselor for elementary students here in Dallas for many years.)

3. The students showed such a *tremendous* amount of empathy that day and the two weeks that followed. They *all* taught me a huge lesson: "Sometimes we take children for granted. They are not just little kids, but they are amazing young people with the most gigantic hearts!"

-Side note- if you have a child in one of these schools, you should be extremely proud of them.
